THIS QUARTER'S MUSIC

#1 - "The Limerick Waltz" is from "The Roche Collection of Traditional Irish Music, Vol III" published in 1927. It's in the section, "Old Dances (Not Irish by Origin)." The preface says that in these melodies, "a substitute may be found to some extent for the vulgar, inane and noisy stuff called dance music in vogue at present." Sounds like it could have been written by us or our parents! #2 - I finally found a Civil War hymn! I found "Old North State" (not the one they teach in schools) on a 1960 recording in our library, "The Civil War - Its Music and Its Sounds." It's from Book One of the Regiment Band of the 26th North Carolina. It has an odd rhythm in the first half, but it's a nice piece. #3 - While I was at the library I got out a Christmas CD (in mid-July!) by the Vienna Boy's Choir and found "Er Is Een Kindeke Geboren Op Aard'." Sorry, I didn't catch the lyrics, and they didn't translate the title. I hope you like this pretty little Christmas tune.






