### THIS QUARTER'S TUNES


Alright – just one more from the "Library Discard" books for kids. "Wu Ya, Wu Ya (Song of the Crow)" is a pretty Chinese folksong from a 1956 schoolbook, "Music Across Our Country." Maybe we'll have a repeat of a few years ago when a Chinese lady came up to us at the Folk Art Center and began singing that month's newsletter song in Chinese as we played!

The February tune, "The Banks of Allan," is a Scottish one from "The Gow Collection of Scottish Dance Music" listed in the "Medleys" section. It could have been our January tune in celebration of Robert Burns' birthday, but I thought we might need an extra month of practice. (Don't be scared by the small "grace notes" in four of the measures. You can ignore them if you don't know what they are!)

For March, we have a Saint Patrick's Day Irish tune – "The Rakes of Mallow." This is a well-known "session tune," and although it's usually played much too fast, it is shown as an "Irish Country Dance," so I think we can take it a bit slower in deference to the dancers!

## MEETING LOCATION/TIME

The Club meets in the upstairs gallery, across from the top of the ramp as you enter the Folk Art Center.

Handicapped Access is available: From Highway 70, go West from the Parkway just past the VA Medical Center to Riceville Road. Go to the Folk Art Center Service Entrance. A ramp leads to a second floor entrance next to where we set up.
