
### **DULCIMER CLUB NEWS**

<u>MONTHLY TUNES</u>: All songs this quarter are from Songs of Many Lands – The World of Music published in 1936 – another book sale find. They're listed as folk tunes, although the English lyrics were all made up for the book, so I'm just including the tunes, here. For <u>October</u>: "Little Gobbelin" from Denmark. Seems appropriate! For <u>November</u>: "Castle by the Sea" from Spain. For <u>December</u>: "Sunny Italy" will give us someplace else to think about as the weather turns chilly. (The tune is credited to Gaetano Donizetti, although I can't find anything listed close to this title. Any opera lovers able to recognize this one?) Our annual "extra" tune for <u>Christmas</u>: "Christmas Eve" is listed as "Bohemian-Czech".



## **MEETING LOCATION/TIME**

Second Sunday of each month from 2:30-5:00 at The Folk Art Center Upstairs Gallery, Blue Ridge Parkway, Asheville

The Folk Art Center is located on the Blue Ridge Parkway at Milepost 382, about 1/2 mile North of US 70, just East of Asheville. Take I-40 Exit 55 to Highway 70, then left to the Parkway, or take I-240 Exit 7 and go East on Highway 70 to the Parkway. The Club meets in the upstairs gallery, across from the top of the ramp as you enter the Folk Art Center.

Handicapped Access is available: From Highway 70, go West from the Parkway just past the VA Medical Center to Riceville Road. Go to the Folk Art Center Service Entrance. A ramp leads to a second floor entrance next to where we set up.
